Parish Council News

KCC Community Warden Consultation

Kent County Council (KCC) is currently consulting on significant changes to the Community Warden Service in Kent, which the Parish Council believes could substantially affect the support which residents are used to receiving in Harrietsham currently. If the proposals are approved, the service will follow a Geographical Allocation Policy, moving Wardens to the areas with the greatest need. Across the whole of the County, the proposal includes plans to reduce the currently employed 54 Wardens to 32, which will result in the remaining Wardens covering a much larger area than they do now. The services offered currently by each Warden are likely to be reduced quite dramatically.

This consultation closes on the 3 October and we would ask that as many residents as possible complete the questionnaire that has been produced by KCC.

The form can be completed in two ways:

On-line: www.kent.gov.uk/communitywardenreview (or Google: KCC Community Warden review)

Paper form: Please contact the Parish Clerk, any Parish Councillor or our Community Warden, Martin Sherwood, who will be able to give you a paper copy to complete.

If completing the paper form questionnaire, please do not send this back to KCC through the post. Your completed form can be dropped through the Parish Office door, given to any Parish Councillor or returned directly to Martin, who will arrange for them to be hand delivered on your behalf.

Martin is a valuable asset to the village and we need to try to do everything we can to protect this service for residents.

Rural Hedge Cutting

The Parish Council will be arranging the hedge cutting service again this year and it is hoped that this will commence at the beginning of November. If you wish to have your name added to the list, please contact the Clerk. Please note that you will still need to add your name to the list, even if you have used the service in the past.





Update from Len Valley Practice

In line with NHSE guidance, Len Valley Practice will be supporting this year's Flu and Covid vaccination campaign. This is due to start Friday 22 September. The vaccinations will be co-administered as set out in the guidance. Patients residing in care homes and those Housebound will be prioritised by our PCN team.

Len Valley Practice intends to run clinics from 22 September both at Harrietsham and Len Valley and will include weekends to get as many patients vaccinated as quickly as possible.

The practice will advertise the clinics and will be sending out direct booking links (only valid for 7 days) to all those we hold mobile phone numbers for, in addition to telephone contact with the help of the PPG.

We would like to remind patients of the issues with parking in recent years and encourage as many attending the clinics to walk where possible.



Christian Message

Do not despair

When a calamity happens in life, we tend to try to just deal with it. It might make us tired, irritable and anxious, but we try to focus, prioritise and move on. Depending on the size of the problem, we may deal with our feelings by discussion with family or friends, or may tell no-one for fear of judgement or reprisal.

When a couple of calamities happen, we have to balance both, a bit more of a challenge and a bit more to deal with in terms of emotions. In short, we are stretched and it is harder to share our thoughts about both things adequately with those we know and love.

When several calamities happen at once we can feel completely overwhelmed, not knowing how to juggle so many balls in the air or where our priorities lie. Trying to explain all this to others can feel like yet another hurdle to jump over. It is the culmination of multiple problems that can lead to depression and despair.

In 1 Kings 19 we can read that Elijah was despairing and in fear of his life. After running away, he stopped, exhausted, ready to give up. In Genesis 39 we can read how Joseph was imprisoned for something he hadn't done and had a bleak future to look forward to. In both cases, however, God sent help, enabling them to find the strength to carry on and achieve more.

There are no quick fixes when life gets tough. We might need to turn to a helpline to talk through our concerns, seek advice from a doctor or engage with a professional councillor or advisor. Like those in the Bible, we also have the option to pray and ask God to guide us through our darkest hours.

My experience is this that God really does answer prayer and, not only addresses our immediate concerns, but sometimes paves the way to something better that we hadn't thought of. Blessings can come out of adversity. We need to be prepared to be patient, prepared for change, and prepared for prayers to be answered in a way other than the one we are expecting or want. God is listening, caring, and has a plan for us all.

Philippians 4, verse 6 says:

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.

In 2 Corinthians, chapter 4, we read:

'We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. Therefore, we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.'

Sometimes, when things seem bleak, it is hard to pray for ourselves. If you would like someone to pray for you or with you, please do fill in a prayer card in one of our benefice Churches, or why not come along to a Church service and talk to someone afterwards.
